**1. CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL**

Rick Reidt called the Landowner's Election of the Board of Supervisors of the La Collina Community Development District to order on **Monday, November 07, 2022, at 6:08 p.m.**

**2. APPOINTMENT OF MEETING CHAIRMAN**

Mr. Reidt from Inframark stated that he will be serving as the meeting chairman.

**3. ANNOUNCEMENT OF CANDIDATES/CALL FOR NOMINATIONS**

Mr. Reidt requested all ballots and proxies be presented.

Mr. Reidt briefly went over the election process and announced the candidates: Rajesh Chitla and Scott Tatum.

Nominations were taken with Scott Tatum nominated. Mr. Chitla asked what the requirements to hold office were and Mr. Reidt responded.

The Election took place and Mr. Scott Tatum was elected with thirty-seven proxies submitted and Mr. Chitla's verbal vote.

**4. ELECTION OF SUPERVISORS**

The ballots and proxies were collected, and the votes were tallied. Mr. Reidt proceeded with announcing the results: Scott Tatum received thirty-seven (37) votes and will serve for Seat 2 with a four-year term.

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54 The landowner's election was adjourned.

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


